



Welcome to YVC!

If you plan to attend full- or part-time and are pursuing a degree or certificate in either a transfer or professional technical program you must apply for admission to the college and take a placement test or provide transcripts for evaluation before the deadline. When you complete the admission and placement process you will be eligible to schedule your new student orientation session. If you have 30+ college level credits evaluated by YVC a registration date will be assigned to you. Follow the steps on the reverse of this brochure.

Students who are interested in taking classes but are not pursuing a degree or certificate must meet class prerequisites which may include placement scores or previous successful course completion.

Important Reminders

Pay Your Tuition on Time

Tuition is due before the beginning of each quarter. Students who fail to pay tuition may be dropped from their classes. Please contact Registration for specific tuition due dates. If your funding is through an agency, scholarship or financial aid, be sure those payment sources have paid your tuition on time! Ultimately, it is your responsibility to see that your tuition is paid by published tuition due dates.

Step #1. Admissions

- Apply now for admission online at www.yvcc.edu/apply or in person in the Deccio Higher Education Center.

- Pay the \$30 admission fee by mail or in person.

Step #3. Prepare to Test

- Watch the online Placement Orientation and review other important information, such as study resources, testing schedule and cost at: www.yvcc.edu/placement.

Step #4. Placement Testing

- YVC has many paths for you to find your starting points in English & math. Most courses have placement prerequisites for writing and math ability and all new students must have placements in order to register for classes. Visit www.yvcc.edu/placement to see all the options you have to find your English and math placements. You should complete the placement process within two weeks of admission.

- If you have taken a placement test at another college within the last two years you can request the institution who administered the test to fax your results to the YVC Testing Center at 509.574.4849.

- If you have successfully completed English and/or math courses at another college, send an official transcript to Admissions.

Step #5. Transcripts

- If you have attended another college or university, please request an official copy of your transcripts to be sent to the YVC Admissions Office.

- YVC no longer requires high school transcripts or GED certificates for general admission except as prerequisites for chemistry and/or biology.

- Many of the special admissions programs require transcripts as well. Please send a second official transcript directly to the program.

Step #6. Orientation & Registration

When you have completed the application process and provided Admissions with your placement scores or transcripts, you will be eligible to schedule an orientation and registration date. Students with 30+ college level credits evaluated by YVC, are not required to attend New Student Orientation.

Other Credits Accepted

- YVC grants college credit for the following programs: Advanced Placement (AP), College Level Examination Program (CLEP), International Baccalaureate (IP) and college in the high school. If you have participated in any of these programs please submit an official transcript or test results to the Admissions Office.
