Date	Important Date Information
<b>Feb 8</b>	Spring Quarter class schedule available on the Student Portal.
<b>Feb 8</b>	Spring Quarter advance registration times available on the Student Portal for currently enrolled students.
<b>Feb 9</b>	Summer 2021 graduation application deadline
<b>Feb 10 – Feb 19</b>	Advance Spring Quarter registration begins for currently enrolled degree/certificate seeking students.
<b>Feb 15</b>	President’s Day Holiday – College Closed
<b>Feb 22</b>	Returning and transfer student (30+ college credits) Spring Quarter 2021 registration begins.
<b>Feb 23</b>	<b>Deadline:</b> All transcripts (college and High School) must be received for Spring Quarter 2021 for full or part-time transfer student admission.
<b>Feb 23</b>	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to apply and pay admission fee for Spring Quarter 2021 admission for new, *returning, and transfer full or part-time students seeking a degree or certificate.
<b>Mar 2</b>	**Tuition due by 3:30pm for Spring Quarter 2021 if registered on or before this date.
<b>Mar 4</b>	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day for students to complete placement (testing or High School transcripts) and schedule New Student Orientation appointment in <b>Yakima and Grandview</b> .
<b>Mar 15 - 18</b>	New Student Orientation: By appointment only. Call the Admissions Office at 509.574.4712 for details.
<b>Mar 22 – Mar 29</b>	Spring Vacation - Limited college services available.
<b>Mar 23</b>	**Tuition due by 3:30 pm for Spring Quarter 2021 if registered on or before this date.
<b>Mar 16 – Mar 29</b>	Spring Quarter registration begins for part-time non-degree/certificate seeking students.
<b>Mar 23 – Apr 6</b>	Financial Aid Phone Hours M-Th 8:00 am – 3:00 pm; outside of these hours please leave detailed voicemail or email <a href="mailto:finaid@yvcc.edu">finaid@yvcc.edu</a>
<b>Mar 30</b>	Spring Quarter 2021 classes begin.
<b>Mar 30 – Mar 31</b>	Students can add a class on <b>Student Portal</b> , no instructor signature needed.
<b>Apr 1 – Apr 5</b>	Students can add a class with instructor email. Class adds will need to be completed using <b>Add/Drop Form</b> .
<b>Mar 30 – Apr 5</b>	Refunds- 100% refund period ends April 5 <sup>th</sup> . Drops can be completed on <b>Student Portal</b> or by using the <b>Add/Drop Form</b> .
<b>Mar 30 – Apr 12</b>	Students can drop a class in this period and the class does not appear on transcript. <b>All drops after Apr 5<sup>th</sup> must be done using the Add/Drop Form</b>
<b>Apr 6 – Apr 19</b>	Refunds- 50% refund period ends on April 19 <sup>th</sup> . Drops must be completed by using the <b>Add/Drop Form</b>
<b>Apr 13 – May 14</b>	Students can withdraw from a class in this period and the grade appears as a “W” on transcript. Drops must be completed by using the <b>Add/Drop Form</b> .
<b>Apr 18</b>	Faculty deadline for ordering caps and gowns.
<b>Apr 20</b>	Incomplete grades for Winter Quarter 2021 due in Records & Registration Office
<b>May 4</b>	Advising Day – No day time classes are held on advising day. Evening classes that begin after 6:30pm are held at their normal times. All Bachelor of Applied Science classes follow their regular schedule.
<b>May 14</b>	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to withdraw from Spring Quarter. Drops must be completed by using the <b>Add/Drop Form</b>
<b>May 17</b>	Fall Quarter 2021 graduation application deadline.
<b>May 25</b>	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to submit Winter/Spring/Summer 2021 degree/certificate applications to be included in the June commencement program.
<b>May 31</b>	Memorial Day Holiday – College Closed
<b>Jun 4</b>	Last day of classes for Spring Quarter.
<b>Jun 7 – Jun 9</b>	Spring Quarter final exams.
<b>Jun 11</b>	Grades due in Registration & Records Office by 4:00 pm. (No classes)
<b>Jun 16</b>	Grades available on the Student Portal.
<b>Jun 18</b>	Commencement – at 7:00 pm

\* Returning students are students who have not attended YVC for the last four or more quarters (not including summer).

\*\* If you are receiving financial aid assistance you are responsible for verifying that your funds are ready to apply to tuition and fees. Currently enrolled students may be dropped from all classes if your tuition is not paid by this date.
