Date	Important Date Information
Oct 26	Winter Quarter class schedule available on the <a href="#">Student Portal</a> .
Oct 26	Winter Quarter advance registration times available on the Student Portal for currently enrolled students.
Nov 3	Currently enrolled degree/certificate seeking VA students eligible to register
Nov 4 – Nov 13	Advance Winter Quarter registration begins for currently enrolled degree/certificate seeking students.
Nov 18	<b>Deadline:</b> All transcripts (college and High School) must be received for Winter Quarter 2021 for full or part-time transfer student admission.
Nov 18	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to apply and pay admission fee for Winter Quarter 2021 admission for new, *returning, and transfer full or part-time students seeking a degree or certificate.
Nov 16	Returning and transfer student (30+ college credits) Winter Quarter 2021 registration begins.
Nov 30	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day for students to complete placement (testing or High School transcripts) and schedule <a href="#">New Student Orientation</a> appointment in <b>Yakima and Grandview</b> .
Dec 7	**Tuition due by 3:30pm for Winter Quarter 2021 if registered on or before this date.
Dec 7 - 10	New Student Orientation: By appointment only. Call the Admissions Office at 509.574.4712 for details.
Dec 14 – Dec 31	Winter holiday break- Limited college services available.
Dec 25	Christmas Holiday – College closed.
Dec 28 – Dec 31	Winter Quarter registration begins for part-time non-degree/certificate seeking students.

Jan 1	New Year’s Holiday – College closed.
Jan 4	Winter Quarter 2021 classes begin.
Jan 4 – Jan 5	Students can add a class on <a href="#">Student Portal</a> , no instructor signature needed.
Jan 6 – Jan 8	Students can add a class with instructor email. Class adds will need to be completed using <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a> .
Jan 4 – Jan 8	Refunds- 100% refund period ends on January 8 <sup>th</sup> . Drops can be completed on <a href="#">Student Portal</a> or by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a> and submitted to Registration.
Jan 8	**Tuition due by 3:30pm for Winter Quarter 2021 if registered after January 8 <sup>th</sup> .
Jan 4 – Jan 15	Students can drop a class in this period and the class does not appear on transcript. <b>All drops after Jan 8 must be done using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a></b>
Jan 9 – Jan 22	Refunds- 50% refund period ends on January 22 <sup>nd</sup> . Drops must be completed by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
Jan 16 – Feb 19	Students can withdraw from a class in this period and the grade appears as a “W” on transcript. Drops must be completed by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
Jan 18	Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday - College closed.
Feb 2 – Feb 9	<b>Advising Days</b> – Yakima Valley College is providing mandatory advising via phone and email for students with less than 30 college level credits at YVC. Your advisor will call or email you to schedule an advising time.
Feb 8	Incomplete grades for Fall Quarter 2020 due in Records & Registration Office.
Feb 8	Summer Quarter 2021 graduation application deadline.
Feb 15	President’s Day Holiday – College closed.
Feb 19	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to withdraw from Winter Quarter. Drops must be completed by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
Mar 1	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to submit Winter/Spring/Summer 2021 degree/certificate applications to be included in the June commencement program.
Mar 12	Last day of classes for Winter Quarter.
Mar 15 – Mar 17	Winter Quarter final exams.
Mar 19	Grades due in Registration & Records Office by 4:00pm. (No classes)
Mar 22 – Mar 29	Spring Vacation, limited college services available.
Mar 23	Grades available on the <a href="#">Student Portal</a> .

\* Returning students are students who have not attended YVC for the last four or more quarters (not including summer).

\*\* If you are receiving financial aid assistance you are responsible for verifying that your funds are ready to apply to tuition and fees. Currently enrolled students may be dropped from all classes if your tuition is not paid by this date.
