STEM majors offer exciting educational opportunities. Start your educational path to a successful career today!



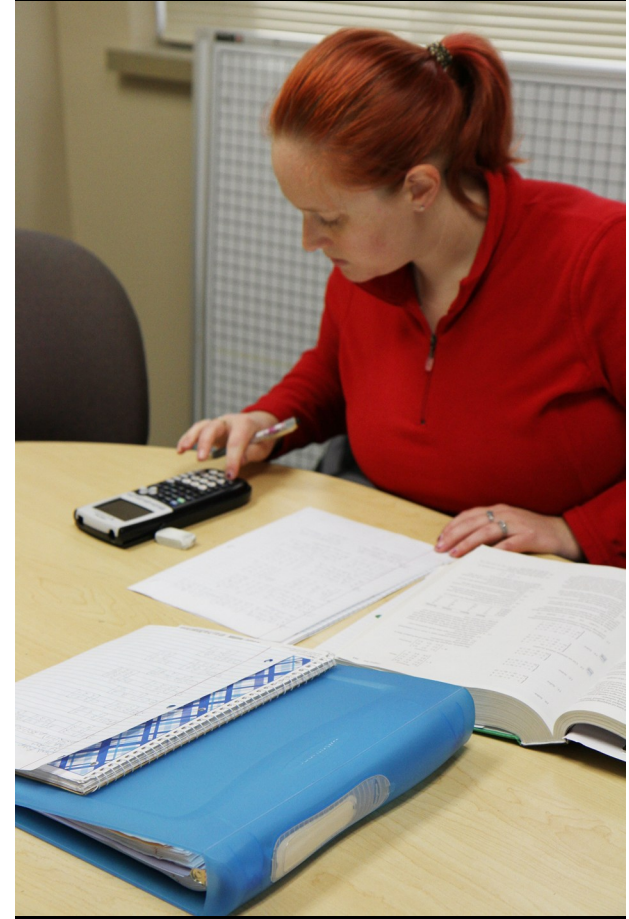
