Yakima Valley College Upward Bound is funded by the U.S. Department of Education and serves students from Wapato, Toppenish, Granger, and Sunnyside school districts. Upward Bound supports low-income and first-generation students with the high school and college process. Students benefit from additional career and class guidance, academic preparation and college/scholarship support. Our goal is to prepare and graduate students from high school and enroll into a post-secondary institution of their choosing.

Who is Eligible?

- Low-income and/or first-generation students
- Entering 9th, 10th or 11th grade
- From Wapato, Toppenish, Granger and Sunnyside high schools
- U.S. Citizen or legal Permanent Resident
- In need of academic support/resources

- Guidance in navigating the college and scholarship process
- Tutoring support and Saturday seminars
- Assistance with class and career planning
- A unique 6-week summer residential program that provides a true college experience
- College campus tours and connections
- Computer and calculator lending system
- Monthly stipend, up to \$40 a month for participation
- One-on-one advising with Upward Bound Staff
