

International Student General Requirements Sheet

Online (Distance) Classes

- No more than the equivalent of one on-line/distance education class or 3 credits per session may count towards the “full course of study” requirement. If the student’s course of study is in a language study program, no on-line or distance education classes may be counted toward the full course of study requirement.
- If a student needs only one course to finish his or her program of study, it cannot be taken through online/distance education.

Full Course of Study

- Continue to carry a full course of study (12 or more credits each quarter).
- EXCEPTION: Student may be authorized to attend less than full course of study only with prior approval of DSO (International Student Manager). Interpretation of rule is that student must have continuous enrollment throughout each quarter until completion of an academic program. This requirement does not apply during summer quarter.

Satisfactory Progress

- Continue to make satisfactory progress to achieve academic goal. Satisfactory progress is interpreted to mean a 2.0 G.P.A.

Employment

- On Campus
 - Limited to 20 hours per week while school is in session; can be full-time during official school breaks
- Off Campus
 - Refrain from off-campus employment without authorization.

Documentation

- Maintain valid form I-20 and renew it prior to its expiration date.
- Retain a valid passport at all times.
