**1. Revision of WAC 132P-33 Student Rights and Responsibilities-Emergency Rulemaking**

Leslie Blackaby presented to the Board of Trustees the revisions to federal regulations on Title IX, Part 106-Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Sex in Education Programs or Activities Receiving Federal Financial Assistance necessitate revisions to the college’s WAC 132P-33 Code of Student Conduct. The federal regulations are in effect August 1, 2024. The proposed WAC’s 132P-121-010 through 132P-121-540 are presented to the board following approval from the Board of Trustees, the college will follow the prescribed procedures for emergency rulemaking. YVC’s current WACs will continue to apply to incidents allegedly occurring July 31, 2024, and prior. Upon approval by the Board of Trustees and completion of the emergency rule making process, WACs 132P-121-010 through 540 would be in effect for 120 days during which time the college would pursue the permanent rule making process as required by the state of Washington’s Code Reviser’s office.

**MOTION 24-07-06:** Trustee Ortega moved that the Board of Trustees adopt a motion to approve emergency rulemaking for the adoption of WACs 132P-121-010 through 132P-121-540.



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The motion was seconded Chair Baldoz and passed unanimously.
