Oct 25	Winter Quarter class schedule available on the Student Portal.
Oct 25	Winter Quarter advance registration times available on the Student Portal for currently enrolled students.
Nov 3	Currently enrolled degree/certificate seeking VA students eligible to register
Nov 4 – Nov 12	Advance Winter Quarter registration begins for currently enrolled degree/certificate seeking students.
Nov 23	<b>Deadline:</b> All transcripts (college and High School) must be received for Winter Quarter 2022 for full or part-time transfer student admission.
Nov 23	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to apply and pay admission fee for Winter Quarter 2022 admission for new, *returning, and transfer full or part-time students seeking a degree or certificate.
Nov 15	Returning and transfer student (30+ college credits) Winter Quarter 2022 registration begins.
Nov 30	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day for students to complete placement (testing or High School transcripts) and schedule New Student Orientation appointment in <b>Yakima and Grandview</b> .
Dec 6	**Tuition due by 3:30pm for Winter Quarter 2022 if registered on or before this date.
Dec 9	New Student Orientation: By appointment only. Call the Admissions Office at 509.574.4712 for details.
Dec 13 – Dec 31	Winter holiday break- Limited college services available.
Dec 24	Christmas Day - Observed Holiday - College closed.
Dec 27 – Dec 30	Winter Quarter registration begins for part-time non-degree/certificate seeking students.
Dec 27 – Dec 30	Extended hours for Financial Aid (9:30am - 3:00pm)
Dec 31	New Year's Holiday (observed) – College closed.
Jan 3	Winter Quarter 2022 classes begin. Last day to adjust enrollment level for Financial Aid (FA Census Date)
Jan 3 – Jan 4	Students can add a class on <a href="#">Student Portal</a> , no instructor/signature email needed.
Jan 3 – Jan 4	Extended evening hours for Registration (7:30am - 6:00pm)
Jan 3 – Jan 4	Extended evening hours for the Yakima Bookstore (7:30am – 7:00pm).
Jan 3 – Jan 6	Extended hours for Financial Aid (9:30am - 3:00pm)
Jan 3 – Jan 7	Refunds- 100% refund period ends on January 7 <sup>th</sup> .
Jan 5 – Jan 7	Students can add a class with instructor email/signature. Class adds must be completed on an <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a> .
Jan 3 – Jan 14	Students can drop a class in this period and the class does not appear on transcript. All drops after January 7 <sup>th</sup> must be completed on an <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a> and submitted to Registration.
Jan 7	**Tuition due by 3:30pm for Winter Quarter 2022 if registered on or before January 7 <sup>th</sup> .
Jan 8 – Jan 21	Refunds- 50% refund period ends on January 21 <sup>st</sup> .
Jan 15 – Feb 18	Students can withdraw from a class in this period and the grade appears as a “W” on transcript. Drops must be completed on an <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a> .
Jan 17	Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday - College closed.
Feb 7	Incomplete grades for Fall Quarter 2021 due in Records & Registration Office.
Feb 7	Summer Quarter 2022 graduation application deadline.
Feb 8	Advising Day – No day time classes are held on advising day. Evening classes that begin after 6:30pm are held at their normal times. All Bachelor of Applied Science classes follow their regular schedule.
Feb 21	President's Day Holiday – College closed.
Feb 18	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to withdraw from Winter Quarter. Drops must be completed on an <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a> .
Mar 1	<b>Deadline:</b> Last day to submit Winter/Spring/Summer 2022 degree/certificate applications to be included in the June commencement program.
Mar 11	Last day of classes for Winter Quarter.
Mar 14 – Mar 16	Winter Quarter final exams.
Mar 14 – Mar 16	Book buyback in <b>Grandview</b> March 16 <sup>th</sup> (10:00 am – 5:00pm) and <b>Yakima</b> March 14-16 (7:30am – 7:00pm)
Mar 18	Grades due in Registration & Records Office by 4:00pm.
Mar 21 – Mar 28	Spring Vacation, limited college services available.
Mar 22	Grades available on the Student Portal.

\* Returning students are students who have not attended YVC for the last four or more quarters (not including summer).

\*\* If you are receiving financial aid assistance you are responsible for verifying that your funds are ready to apply to tuition and fees. Currently enrolled students may be dropped from all classes if your tuition is not paid by this date.
