Feb 8	Currently enrolled degree/certificate seeking VA students eligible to register
Feb 9 – Feb 18	Advance Spring Quarter registration begins for currently enrolled degree/certificate seeking students
Feb 21	President’s Day Holiday – College Closed
Feb 22	*Returning and transfer student (30+ college credits) Spring Quarter 2022 registration begins
Feb 22	Deadline: All transcripts (college and High School) must be received for Spring Quarter 2022 for full or part-time transfer student admission
Feb 22	Deadline: Last day to apply and pay admission fee for Spring Quarter 2022 admission for new, *returning, and transfer full or part-time students seeking a degree or certificate
Mar 1	**Tuition due by 3:30pm for Spring Quarter 2022 if registered on or before this date
Mar 3	Deadline: Last day for students to complete placement (testing or High School transcripts) and schedule New Student Orientation appointment in Yakima and Grandview.
Mar 21 – Mar 28	Spring Vacation - Limited college services available
Mar 22 – Mar 28	Spring Quarter registration begins for part-time non-degree/certificate seeking students

Mar 29	Spring Quarter 2022 classes begin
Mar 29 – Mar 30	Students can add a class on <a href="#">Student Portal</a> , no instructor signature/email needed
Mar 29 – Apr 4	Refunds- 100% refund period ends April 4th. Drops can be completed on <a href="#">Student Portal</a> or by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a> .
Mar 31 – Apr 4	Students can add a class with instructor email. Class adds will need to be completed using <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
Mar 29 – Apr 11	Students can drop a class in this period and the class does not appear on transcript. All drops after April 4th must be done using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
Apr 4	**Tuition due by 3:30 pm for Spring Quarter 2022 if registered on or before this date
Apr 5 – Apr 18	Refunds- 50% refund period ends on April 18. Drops must be completed by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
Apr 12 – May 5	Students can withdraw from a class in this period and the grade appears as a “W” on transcript. Drops must be completed by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
April 15	Last day for Spring Quarter enrollment and registration changes (By 3:30 pm) – services resume May 23

Apr 19	Incomplete grades for Winter Quarter 2022 due in Records & Registration Office
April 22	Last day for student cashiering transactions (By 3:30 pm) – services resume May 23
May 5	Deadline: Last day to withdraw from Spring Quarter. Withdrawal must be completed by using the <a href="#">Add/Drop Form</a>
May 17	Fall Quarter 2022 graduation application deadline
May 23	Deadline: Last day to submit Winter/Spring/Summer 2022 degree/certificate applications to be included in the June commencement program
May 23	Summer and Fall Quarter class schedules available on Student Portal and ctclink
May 25	Advising Day – No day time classes are held on advising day. Evening classes that begin after 6:30 pm are held at their normal times. All Bachelor of Applied Science classes follow their regular schedule
May 30	Memorial Day Holiday – College Closed
May 31	Summer Quarter registration begins for all students using ctclink
June 1	Fall Quarter advanced registration for currently enrolled students using ctclink
