May 23	Fall Quarter classes are available in the ctcLink Student Portal .
May 23	Advance registration times are available in the ctcLink Student Portal for currently enrolled students.
May 25	Advising Day: No daytime classes are held on advising day. Evening classes that begin after 6:30 p.m. are held at their regular times. All Bachelor of Applied Science classes follow their regular schedule.
May 31	Advance registration begins for currently enrolled degree/certificate-seeking VA students
Jun 1 – Jun 10	Advance registration begins for currently enrolled degree/certificate-seeking students
Jun 13	Advance registration begins for *returning and transfer students (30+ college credits)
Aug 9	Deadline: All transcripts (college and High School) must be received for Fall Quarter 2022 for full or part-time transfer student admission.
Aug 9	Deadline: Last day to apply and pay the admission fee for Fall Quarter 2022 admission for new, *returning, and transfer full or part-time students seeking a degree or certificate.
Aug 16	Deadline: Last day for students to complete placement (testing) and schedule New Student Orientation appointments in Yakima and Grandview.
Aug 22	**Tuition due by 3:30 p.m. for Fall Quarter 2022, if registered on or before August 22.
Aug 30 – Sep 1	New Student Orientation: By appointment only. Call the Admissions Office at 509.574.4712 for details.
Sep 5	Labor Day holiday observed. College closed
Sep 6 – Sep 16	Extended hours for Financial Aid 9:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.
Sep 12 – Sep 16	Registration begins for part-time, non-degree/certificate-seeking students.
Sep 19	Fall Quarter 2022 classes begin.
Sep 19 – Sep 20	Extended evening hours for Registration 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
Sep 19 – Sep 29	Extended hours for Financial Aid 9:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.
Sep 19 – Sep 20	Students can add a class on the ctcLink Student Portal . No instructor signature or email approval required
Sep 19 – Sep 23	Refunds: 100% refund period ends on September 23. Drops can be completed on the ctcLink Student Portal or using the online Add/Drop Form .
Sep 21 – Sep 23	Students can add a class with the instructor's email approval using the online Add/Drop Form .
Sep 26 – Sep 30	Students can drop a class during this period and the class does not appear on the transcript. All drops after September 23 rd must be completed with the online Add/Drop Form
Sep 23	**Tuition due by 3:30 p.m. for Fall Quarter 2022, if registered on or before September 23.
Sep 25 – Oct 7	Refunds: 50% refund period ends on October 7. Drops must be completed with the online Add/Drop Form
Oct 3 – Nov 10	Students can withdraw from a class during this period and the grade appears as a "W" on the transcript. Drops must be completed on an Add/Drop Form .
Oct 17	Assessment Work Day: No day classes
Oct 19	Incomplete grades for Summer Quarter 2022 and Spring Quarter 2022 are due Records & Registration Office.
